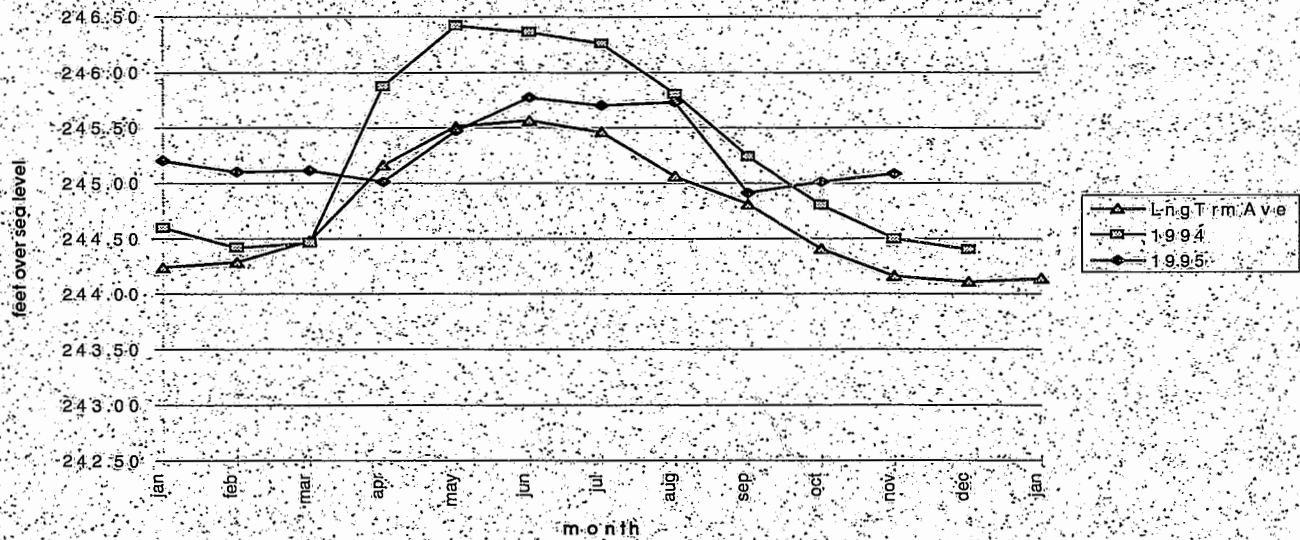

Please contact the Fleet Captain if you have any leads.



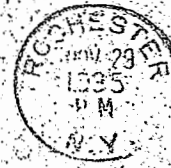
