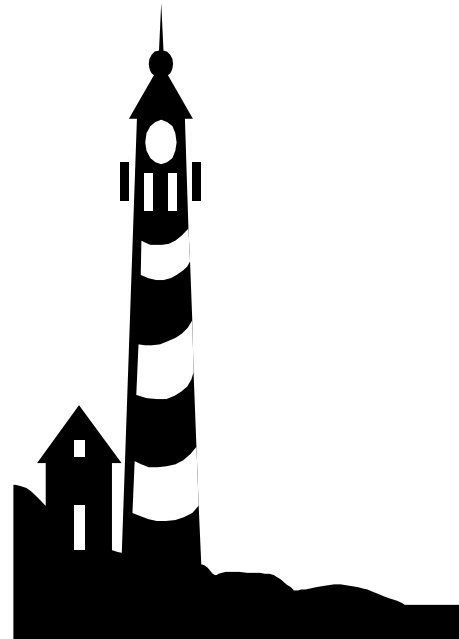

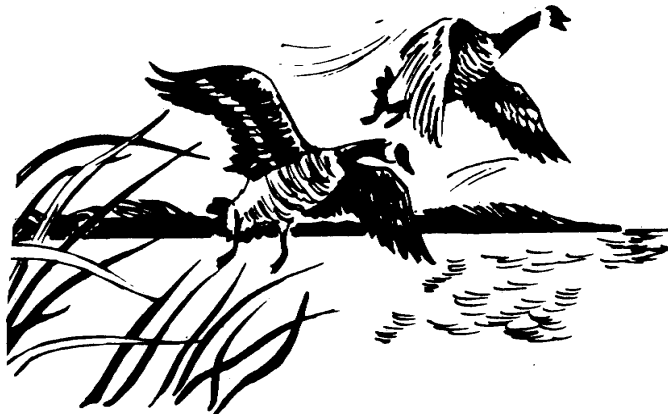
Hi Racers,

The following two By-Law changes will be brought up at the December General Meeting and are published here for your consideration prior to the meeting.

For Article VII Paragraph B 1.

### **Current**

1. The Vice Commodore shall succeed the Commodore in office during the absence of the Commodore or if the Commodore is unable to complete his/her term.

### **Proposed change**

### **Proposed change**
