The number of boats being hauled at PYC dropped again this year from 56 to 49. We can not go much lower on boat numbers and still have an economical package for people. We will be reviewing what the minimum numbers can be early next year.



As everyone can see, we ran out of time to dredge the harbor this year. The Trust will be dredging early next summer in June or July before the water levels start to drop. As I mentioned at the September meeting we have an agreement with the Trust on new depth levels that will provide enough depth for all of us even if we have low water like this year.

Notes from the Engine Room....

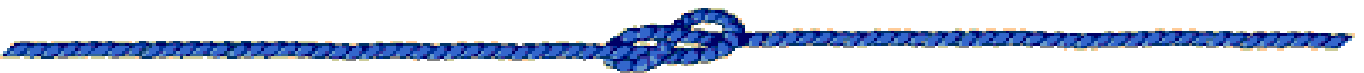
I have to express my sincere thanks for the patience everyone has shown, as we've had to rearrange our haul out schedules. No one expected or wanted the changes forced by the low water levels but I was happy (and relieved) at the flexibility and cooperation from our membership.

By the time this reaches you, the early haul will be complete with a total of around 32 boats on the hard. For the remaining boats in the harbor, please be advised that the water level continues to drop at a rapid rate. This will affect ability to get to the gin pole and even the usability of the ramp. So don't wait too long.

Finally, those hauling and storing boats at PYC this year must read and follow the recommendations of the Shoring Policy that was approved last year. This is in everyone's best interest.
