NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The series will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 A woman must helm the boat during the races and start sequences.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 For entry, a competing vessel must have an active PHRF LO Rating Certificate or be keelboat eligible for a PHRF Certificate. When a certificate is not available, a handicap rating will be assigned by the Organizing Authority's handicap committee.
- 2.2 Entries will be split into fleets at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.
- 2.3 Boats not eligible for a PHRF LO Certificate may enter at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.

3 FEES & REGISTRATION

- 3.1 Registration donation: \$75
- 3.2 Registration: All eligible boats need to be registered to be scored. Boats can register online at the link provided on the flyer. Registration may also be completed June 21st between 0900-0930 at the Pultneyville Yacht Club, Hamilton Street Extension, Pultneyville, NY 14538. Please note that registration may close early depending on slip availability in the PYC harbor. This will be at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.

4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Date of racing: 6/21/2025
- 4.2 There will be a competitor's meeting at 10:00 am on Saturday, June 21st at the PYC Pavillion.
- 4.3 Three (3) races are scheduled. One (1) race will constitute a series.
- 4.4 If no races are completed on Saturday, June 21st, the Organizing Authority has the discretion to reschedule races for Sunday, June 22th, 2025.

5 MEASUREMENTS

- Each boat shall have a valid PHRF-LO certificate.
- (OR)
- Each boat shall produce a valid measurement rating certificate, approved by the Organizing Authority.
- (OR)
- If a boat does not have a PHRF certificate, one will be assigned for this event only.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- The sailing instructions will be available on the Pultneyville Yacht Club Website or during the skippers meeting prior to the first race.

7 VENUE

- 7.1 Attachment C.1 on the PYC website shows the location of the series harbor.
- 7.2 Attachment C.2 on the PYC website shows the location of the racing areas.

8 THE COURSES

- The courses to be sailed will be announced on VHF Channel 71 prior to the starting sequence.

9 PENALTY SYSTEM

The penalties are as follows: Rule 44.1 & 44.2 is in effect. Appendix V1 will apply.

10 SCORING

The Low Point System of Appendix A will apply.

11 RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

1.1 Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones & portable internet devices.

1.2 The Race Committee will attempt to announce boats that are OCS by VHF radio. Failure by the Race Committee to make these announcements or for a boat not to hear them or the order or timing of such announcements shall not be grounds for redress.

12 PRIZES

Flags will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in each division.

13 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the series entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the series.

14 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
